ABOUT THE SHOW:

The Good, The Bad & The Geeky is a podcast that has a few people (mainly Nick Nitro, Jerome Wetzel aka Jimmy and Nathan aka DJ Meat) talk about movies, music, television, video games, comic books and anything else geeky, and maybe occasionally their day to day lives. They also sometimes perform parody songs, and comedy bits and sketches. While the main podcast can go past the PG-13 rating, we keep the sketches PG-13.

The show is usually broken into two segments: The normal “Podcast” section of the show and then the “sketch” side of the show. Sometimes the show could be all one or all the other.

ABOUT THE SKETCHES

Currently (at this time) there are two sketches that we are looking for roles. Some of the roles in said sketches are considered “Legacy” characters, meaning that they are reoccurring or can be reoccurring, while others are guest roles for the month. One sketch is considered 100% original, the other is lovingly borrowing characters from “*Rocky & Friends/The Bullwinkle Show*” from the 1960’s aka *The Adventures of Rocky and Bullwinkle*. Due to the possible difficulties from performing Rocky and Bullwinkle live, this may be recording privately and distributed on the podcast feed for free.

The other sketch that is on-going is a straight up parody of classic sci-fi shows/movies, literally it is Doctor Who from *Doctor Who* meets Doc Brown from *Back to the Future* in a series we call *Why Not Green: Adventures in Space (And Time, Yes the Time is Implied!)*.

We will be setting up the Event Room at Packrat Comics at 6pm, doors open at 6:30pm and our show begins at 7pm.

HOW TO AUDITION

Please record video or audio (either one) and e-mail Nick at goodbadgeeky@gmail.com and be sure to include your name, phone number (and preferred e-mail if the one you use to send is not your preferred e-mail address). Also be sure to verify if you can receive texts via your phone number (and if not, can you provide a cell phone number that is acceptable?).

Please audition for many parts as you like, and make sure your audition is at least 30-60 seconds in length. If you have a few ideas for one character, send them all in. You never know what will work! This isn’t a “you get one stab at it” kinda thing.

ABOUT THIS EPISODE OF WHY NOT GREEN:

The Professor and Doc Green with their new companion MJ go to a planet whose atmosphere makes you act crazy!

PARTS AVAILABLE in WHY NOT GREEN for FREE COMIC BOOK DAY EPISODE – MAY 7TH

RANDOM CITIZEN – Talks in song. A citizen of the planet of Crazaneium, trying to go about his day to day life when he runs into The Professor and Doc Green.

RANDOM CITIZEN 2 – Also talks in song back to a citizen who always talks in song.

TROOP MASTER – A guy in a ‘wrong place at the wrong time’ situation. Can be male or female. Trying to help all around him and is overall a good person with a can-do attitude that gets him into an un-fun situation.

HIKING MEMBER 1 – Naïve, unassuming.

HIKING MEMBER 2 – equally naïve and unassuming as the 1st Hiking Member.

HIKING MEMBER 3 – Evil and... uh... evil?

ABOUT THIS EPISODE OF WHY NOT GREEN:

The Professor and Doc Green with their new companion MJ go to the moon of a planet whose atmosphere makes you act crazy. The moon though? The atmosphere makes you boring. Ironically, they may find someone there. They may be boring as well. (Nah, we’re kidding about that last bit.)

PARTS AVAILABLE in WHY NOT GREEN for MAY 14TH EPISODE

MIKE – A super nice guy. Not sure why he is where he is, which he doesn’t really know that either. He is very smart though, and unassuming. A legacy role. ALSO: As an exercise: please read MIKE as the description previously stated (super nice guy, etc) but then also give a reading as pure evil. Imagine him as the arch-nemesis of The Professor.

Scene for RANDOM CITIZEN 1 and 2-

Note: Please read RANDOM CITIZEN 1 and both 1 and 2 will be cast accordingly

RANDOM CITIZEN

(singing)

Do I normally sing?

Normally sing?

What a very 'normal' question for someone who lives on Crazeanium!

You do not look like you are from around here!

GREEN

(stage whisper)

Great scooter, Professor! He may be on to us!

THE PROFESSOR

(stage whisper)

Nonsense, Doc! Keep at it, you're doing great.

GREEN

We are looking for something weird. Like a shuttle craft landing near here!

RANDOM CITIZEN

(singing, like Thriller)

Shuttle craft-

landing here?

I don't think anything like that is super weird-

Though I do,

think it strange,

you are too normal for our planet- Our Planet-

Planet-

Scene for TROOP MASTER

TROOP MASTER

Meet.com is a great way to find people in your local community you share interests with!

NARRATOR

Okay, nuff of the plug.

TROOP MASTER

Sorry.

NARRATOR

The Troop Master led the small rag-tag-team of the MeetUp Hiker's club and his boy scout troop up until he realized something!

TROOP MASTER

Hey, wait, I just realized something. There are seven of you, right?

Scene for TROOP MASTER, HIKING MEMBER 1, 2 and 3

HIKING MEMBER 3
(backstage)
Help!

NARRATOR
Quickly the search party enters the cave, as the light from the outside world closed in behind them.

HIKING MEMBER 2
Hello?

TROOP MASTER
What in the world is that?

HIKING MEMBER 2
What in the heck?

HIKING MEMBER 1
Looks like silver-blood?

NARRATOR
The whole group approaches the source of the lights, which as far as they can tell, are broken, shattered and connected to a horribly bent metal-like frame and tons of what seems like computer chips. Leading one of the search party to say:

HIKING MEMBER 1
It's a garbage dump!

HIKING MEMBER 3
(backstage)
No! It is... evolution!
(evil laugh)

NARRATOR
The other voice says, echoing through out the cave. And like that, electricity shoots out of the light and illuminates the cave, as both members of the party screams in pain and agony!

HIKING MEMBER 1
Oh the pain!

HIKING MEMBER 2
Oh the ag-o-nee!

NARRATOR
A little more seriously, please.

Scene for MIKE

NOTE: Please do two takes per MIKE Audition: One as evil and the other as super nice.

MIKE
Quickly! This way!

GREEN
Who are you?

MIKE
There is no time to explain. Come with me if you want to not get attacked!

THE PROFESSOR
Oi, what about "Come with me if you want to live?" Boring!

MJ
Don't know about you two but I like not being hurt!

MIKE
This way!

NARRATOR
The figure leads MJ, Doc Green and The Professor away down a hall, down another hall, turning left, and going up a flight of stairs and then-
(aside)
Okay this is getting ridiculous.
(continues)
Jumping a head a bit here, the strange new figure leads our plucky crew of the JARVIS towards a dead-end!

GREEN
Great Scooter! A dead end!

MIKE
No it is not!

NARRATOR
The new figure presses a brick on the wall-

THE PROFESSOR
Nothing is happening.

MIKE
Oh crap. Shoot. Sorry. Um-

NARRATOR
He presses the brick in again and then-

MIKE
(loud audible sigh)

ABOUT THIS EPISODE OF THE MAGICALLY UNAUTHENTICATED MISADVENTURES OF ROCKY AND BULLWINKLE:

Picking up right where the movie left off, give or take about 15 years or so, a scientist named REESE URCHER finds a new type of element, only to discover that it may not be that new at all. And only two individuals may know of the true potential. Of course it would be Rocky and Bullwinkle!

Other Important Notes About This Series:

We may perform two to three sketches a show, almost as 'a book-end', if you will. In some cases, we may do '3' episodes. This may be a case by case basis. Please be aware of that.

PARTS AVAILABLE in Rocky and Bullwinkle for FREE COMIC BOOK DAY:

Note: Some of the roles below may or may not extend in to future episodes and thus may be considered 'casting early'.

EDGAR – Making up the team of EDGAR and CHAUNCEY, these two men have done everything, at least once. Perhaps doomed to be co-workers and best friends for life, Edgar and Chauncey are the world's best onlookers. The most observant townsfolk in existence, they often relax on the job or in public places with little or no regard to what is going on around them.

CHAUNCEY – Making up the team of EDGAR and CHAUNCEY, these two men have done everything, at least once. Perhaps doomed to be co-workers and best friends for life, Edgar and Chauncey are the world's best onlookers. The most observant townsfolk in existence, they often relax on the job or in public places with little or no regard to what is going on around them. * Can be open to being a female role

GENERAL WALKEN SUNSHINE – A brass tough as nails character who puts Rocky and Bullwinkle (including Reese Urcher) through the ringer.

SECRETARY – typical cliché secretary role. Preferred female.

CALVIN T. BURNSIDE – an animated cartoon character from the 1961 animated series *Calvin & The Colonel*. He is a big ol dumb bear who always helped his friend "The Colonel" with his get rich quick schemes. CLUTCH – a weasel lawyer named Oliver Wendell Clutch. Is the series big bad. Literally a weasel, and also a lawyer. To hear how he sounds, please check clips on youtube like this: <https://youtu.be/hKGIsQVDDMMY?t=15m9s>
He sounds offly like Fearless Leader (more likely as the both voices were more likely provided by Paul Frees) and as such, I am very willing to hear different takes on the role!

NOTE: Due to a plot point in the show, please be sure to include two takes of Clutch: One of his normal speaking voice and another as if that voice is using some type of device to 'mask his voice', as due to the first few times he is heard, he is using something to cover up his voice.

Scene for CLUTCH:

Note: please be sure to include two takes of Clutch: One of his voice like the cartoon (see link above) and another as if that voice is using some type of device to 'mask his voice'.

CLUTCH

-which leads me to why I have led you here today.

NATASHA

Good timing with remote, dahling.

CLUTCH

It is a job that only you two can do.

BORIS

And?

CLUTCH

Kill Rocky and Bullwinkle.

BORIS

Bah. We never win.

CLUTCH

I know what you're thinking. That you never win.

NATASHA

He is good, dahling.

CLUTCH

-that for years the doofish good luck of Rocky and Bullwinkle has somehow foiled you time and time again, leading to explosions and pain of cartoonish proportions.

BORIS

Oy vey, he isn't kidding.

CLUTCH

No longer are we in a cartoon show. Or a movie. We are in a different time of format. One more deadly than before.

BORIS

Oo. I'm listening. Yes? Yes?

CLUTCH

An unauthorized radio show.

Scene for SECRETARY and GENERAL WALKEN SUNSHINE

SECRETARY

Walken, there is someone here to see you. Three of them. Mr. Reese Urcher, Rocket Squirrel and Bullwinkle Moose, sir.

SUSHINE

No.

It has not been the entire day.

NARRATOR

The G-8 held out his finger, and waited. And waited. Until he pulls out his cell phone, looking at the time, and looks casually up at the plucky Squirrel.

SUSHINE

Oo. The Office is closed. Now it has now been the entire day.

BULLWINKLE

Hey! You can't reject us.

SUSHINE

Yes I can. I am the head of G-8! I am Military General Walken Sushine. And I am here to break it to the two of you. I don't care who you are, but rejection is all about who you "no". So "No" and good-day!

NARRATOR

And with that, General Walken Sushine went into his office, grabbed his coat and hat, and slams his office door on his way out of his reception area.

BULLWINKLE

But Mr. Sushine!

SUSHINE

No!

URCHER

We beg of you!

SUSHINE

No!

Scene for CALVIN BURNSIDE

BORIS

Washed up, Natasha. That is what we are. If we had just-

CALVIN

Or you can get in the car!

NARRATOR

The two spies turned towards a large car with a shadowy figure in the front, the back door open.

CALVIN

My boss would like to have words.

BORIS

Do we pay money?

CALVIN

No. My boss, he pays you.

BORIS

Okay then.

NATASHA

You sure, dahling?

BORIS

Of course. This is America. Where money grows on trees. And car rides from strangers, heh heh.

NARRATOR

And in the car they went, driving along for what seems like hours, until stopping in a factory-

NATASHA

We are in-

BORIS

New Jersey?

NATASHA

What a dump.

BORIS

My kind of place, Poopsie! What do we do now?

CALVIN

Get out of the car and go upstairs.

Scene for EDGAR and CHAUNCEY

NARRATOR

Meanwhile, at the table behind our heroes... three individuals sit.

CHAUNCEY

Now there's something you don't see everyday.

EDGAR

What-what now?

CHAUNCEY

I said "Now there's something you don't see everyday" Edgar.

EDGAR

Oh. What is it?

CHAUNCEY

A talking Moose and a talking squirrel talking about the military.

EDGAR

Oh.

CHAUNCEY

They're talking.

EDGAR

Oh!
